Chapter and Verse Notations

Rom 3:12 or Rom 3:12 NASB = Romans chapter 3, verse 12 from the *New American Standard Bible*.

Chapter and verse are separated by a colon. The abbreviated initials of the version (NASB in the above example) follow.

Rom 8:1-4 = Romans 8, verses 1 through 4

Rom 8:1, 3 and 9a = Romans 8, verses 1, 3, and the first statement in verse 9

Rom 8:1-9:3 = Romans chapter 8, verse 1 through chapter 9, verse 3

Rom 7:1; 8:2 = Romans chapter 7, verse 1 *and* chapter 8, verse 2
(A semicolon separates two different references.)

chap. = chapter

v. = verse vv. = verses
